

Greater Strathmore Neighborhood Association Prospectus

1. Introduction

This prospectus describes the Art Scholarship provided by the Greater Strathmore Neighborhood Association (GSNA). The GSNA Art Scholarship was created to support residents of Strathmore and the young people of Syracuse by assisting young, local artists to study art.

2. Eligibility

To apply to the GSNA Art Scholarship candidates must:

- Be a resident of the greater Syracuse area.
- Be a senior in high school in a Syracuse City High School and/or a Strathmore neighbor
- Be accepted in a college or university program in the United States of America with a major in art.

3. Definitions

“Syracuse ” is defined as bounded by the limits within the City of Syracuse

The boundaries of Strathmore are limited too: the north; Bellevue Avenue between Velasko Road and Onondaga Avenue, east; South Avenue between Glenwood Avenue and Onondaga Avenue. Onondaga Avenue between South Avenue and Bellevue Avenue; south: Glenwood Avenue between Velasko Road and South Avenue (Includes Robineau Road and Wellesley Road, south of Glenwood and entirety of Elmwood Park), west; Velasko Road between Glenwood and Bellevue

4. Value of Award

A grant of \$1000 will be awarded - \$500 going to the student towards the expenses of studying art at the college level and \$500 going to the art department at the high school that the student attends.

5. How can I Apply

The will application will close to applicants on May 1, **2017** and no further applications can be submitted after that date.

6. General Conditions of the Award

Applicants should be aware of the following general conditions:

- Applicant must be accepted to any post-secondary school to study art;
- Applicant must supply a letter of recommendation, portfolio, and cover letter;
- The GSNA reserves the right to publish the names of candidates selected for awards on the GSNA website. By applying for an award, the candidate gives consent for such publication in the event that his/her application is successful;
- Candidates will be notified of their provisional selection for the GSNA Art Scholarship after the GSNA has checked that they meet the eligibility requirements;
- A formal confirmation of the award will be issued when all conditions have been met and when all documentation issued by the GSNA has been returned;
- Candidates are required to sign the declaration in the below application confirming that they are a student in a Syracuse City High School or a Strathmore Neighbor attending any high school.
- Any false declarations will cause at least the GSNA's share of the award to be terminated, even if the course of study has started. In such circumstances, the candidate will be required to refund any payments made by the GSNA in connection with the award;
- All terms and conditions of award are subject to New York State law and practices, and are subject to change by the GSNA;
- The GSNA Art Scholarship may be terminated at any time for reasons of unsatisfactory conduct, progress, or attendance.
